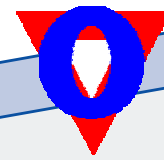


Parent Letter and Important Information



Thank you for registering for February Camp!

CHECK-IN TIME AT CAMP ONYAHSA between 10:00-10:30am, Saturday, February 13th. Any questions and medications can be taken care of during check-in.

CHECK-OUT TIME AT CAMP ONYAHSA 6:00pm Monday, February 15th after our awards ceremony." Parents are invited to attend this brief presentation held in the Dining Hall after dinner. Before departure please inform your camper's Counselor of your identity, and that you are taking the camper home. If someone other than the person who brought the child to Camp will pick him/her up, please notify the child's Counselor on arrival day.

SPECIAL NEEDS If a camper has any special needs, please notify the Camp Director in writing 2 weeks prior to arrival, and please remind us at check-in. (i.e. health, dietary, child custody or other concerns). All medications must be delivered to the Camp staff upon check-in for safe-keeping in locked storage.

COMPLETED HEALTH FORM required for all campers unless camper attended in summer 2009 and nothing has changed.

CAMP SHIRTS AND SWEATSHIRTS will be available for sale at Camp on Monday during checkout.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP Please mark all items with child's name. Camp cannot be held liable for lost items. Children will be outside several times, and clothes may get dirty or wet, so please pack extra clothes, and plenty of warm clothes. Have children notify the staff if items are wet, so that we may dry them.

- Sleeping bag, blanket, sheets, pillow
- **Warm, waterproof boots**
- Warm jacket and snow pants, hat, scarf, gloves or mittens
- Sweater/sweatshirts/hoodie, jeans/pants and t-shirts
- Underclothes, socks and warm pajamas
- **Extra socks, and slippers or shoes for inside activities**
- Personal items (toothbrush, soap, brush, etc.), towels and washcloths
- Homework (there will be time and help for this)
- Flashlight
- Inexpensive camera/film (optional)

PLEASE DO NOT BRING cell phones, electronic games, music boxes, televisions, money, jack knives or any type of weapon, food (*due to health concerns and potential rodent problems*), or any valuable items. *We appreciate your adherence to this policy.*
