

YMCA Camp Onyahsa Family Cottage Rental Information, Summer 2020

Dear Camp Cottage Guests:

Thank you for renting YMCA Camp Onyahsa's Lakefront Cottage this summer. We understand the need for families to spend time outdoors amid the Covid-19 crisis, and are happy to offer this unique venue. However, due to the public health crisis and the concurrent operation of day camps (M-Fs) and Family Camps (weekends), the following rules will apply to Cottage guests. Thank you for your patience as we aim to protect the health of all Camp participants, and your understanding as we prioritize the needs of our youth campers—Onyahsa's primary mission—during your stay.

A Covid-19 screening form must be completed for each family two days prior to arrival. If any member of the household exhibits symptoms of Covid-19 or tests positive for the virus within two weeks prior to arrival, the family must cancel the reservation at no financial penalty.

No visitors are allowed. Site capacity will be limited to six members of the same household due to Covid-19 restrictions and the operation of the youth summer camp.

Check-in will begin after 1:00pm. Check-out must conclude by 10:00am. Apologies, but we cannot welcome early arrivals.

Cottage vehicle limit is two. Vehicles must be parked in designated area. Take caution when backing-up and driving on the Camp Road, as young campers will be traversing it daily. The Speed Limit is 10 mph.

Be mindful that staff live on site with regard to noise and vehicular traffic at night.

No loud music at any time.

No interaction with campers or staff is permissible. Household members must wear face covering (nose and mouth) when within 6 feet of campers or staff.

No alcohol presence allowed outside of cottage before 6:00pm. Alcohol is not permitted more than 12 feet from the cottage. No bottles of any type are permitted on the waterfront.

No empty alcohol containers may be visible outdoors.

Road speed limit is 10 mph and children will traverse it regularly.

No waterfront use without permission of Aquatic Staff; (includes boating, fishing, and swimming).

Boating, fishing, and swimming may only take place within designated and supervised areas. Lifejackets must be worn by all boaters and by any child under the age of 10 who fishes from the dock.

Program areas are unavailable when in use by campers or staff (please inquire). The upper west field is available for cottage renters when archery is not in session. Please inquire.

Household members may not enter any building other than the Lakefront Cottage; these are reserved for other programs and access is limited due to the Covid-19 crisis. Absolutely no restroom use other than the restrooms of the cottage is permissible per the Camp's Child Abuse Prevention Policy.

Please recycle glass/metal/paper/cardboard in appropriate dumpster.

Please discard trash daily in the appropriate dumpster.

Tend to charcoal grill responsibly. Grills may not be placed within 12 feet of cottage.

No tobacco use permitted on site.

Adults must monitor their own minor children at all times. They may have no contact with other campers.

Any medications must be locked inside the cottage.

Please leave the cottage tidy upon departure.

Cottage guests who violate these rules will lose rental privileges and be asked to leave.

Thank you for joining us this summer. Please let us know how we may improve the Cottage experience while maintaining true to our mission to promote excellence in the development of our youth campers.
